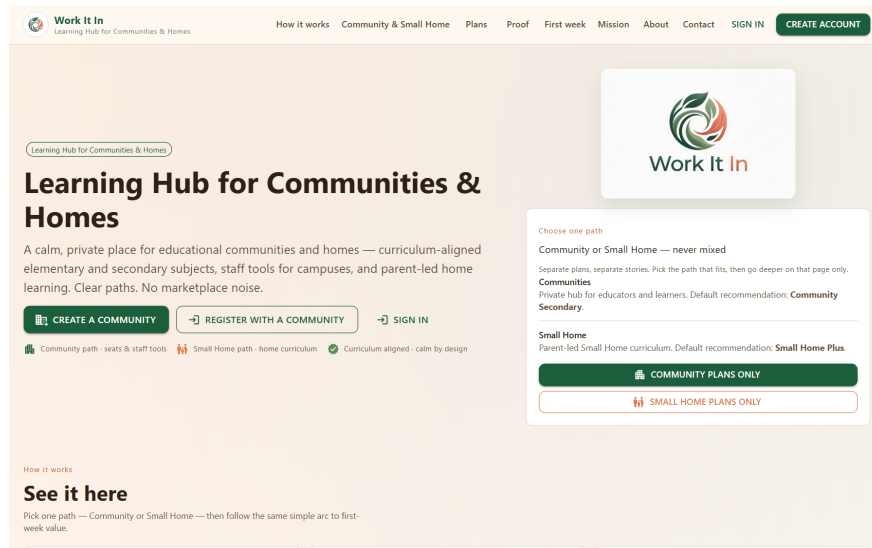

Why Work It In

Two separate paths. Choose Community seats and staff tools, or a Small Home curriculum — never a mixed offer. Default recommendations: **Small Home Plus** and **Community Secondary**.

2. Educator dashboard & staff tools

Teachers and department heads get a practical toolkit focused on teaching outcomes — approving members, assigning learners, shaping modules, and collecting work.

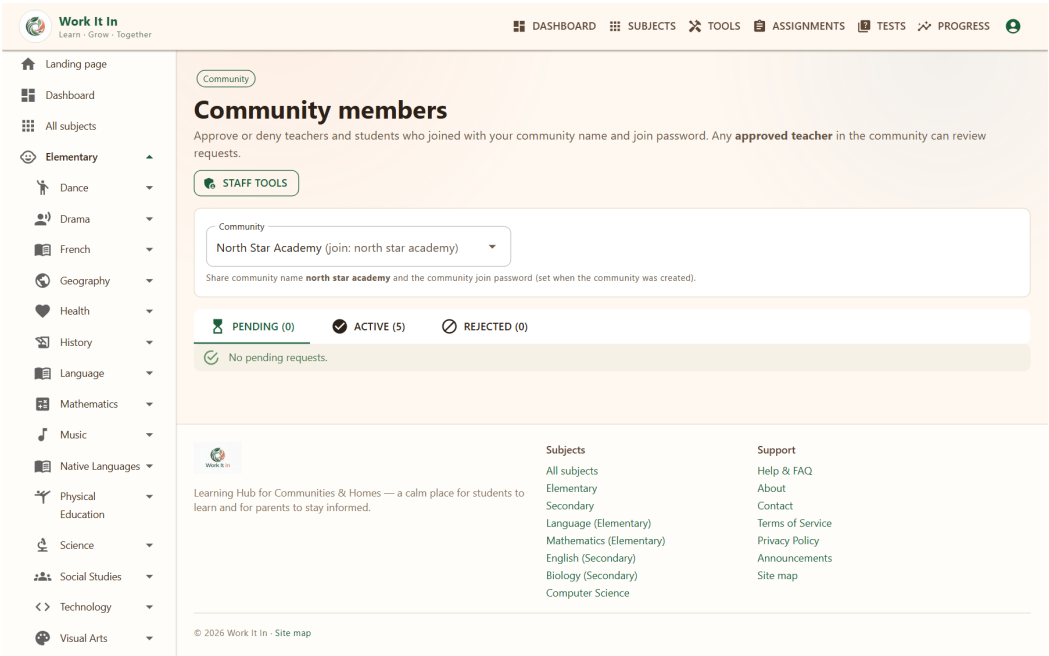

Founding educators create a named community with a join password. New teachers and students request access; educators approve who belongs before full tools unlock.



Community members — approve or deny join requests; keep the hub private.

3. Subject catalog & three pathways

Subjects span elementary and secondary curriculum areas. Each subject can offer up to three pathways so structured study, creative projects, and calm self-paced work can coexist.

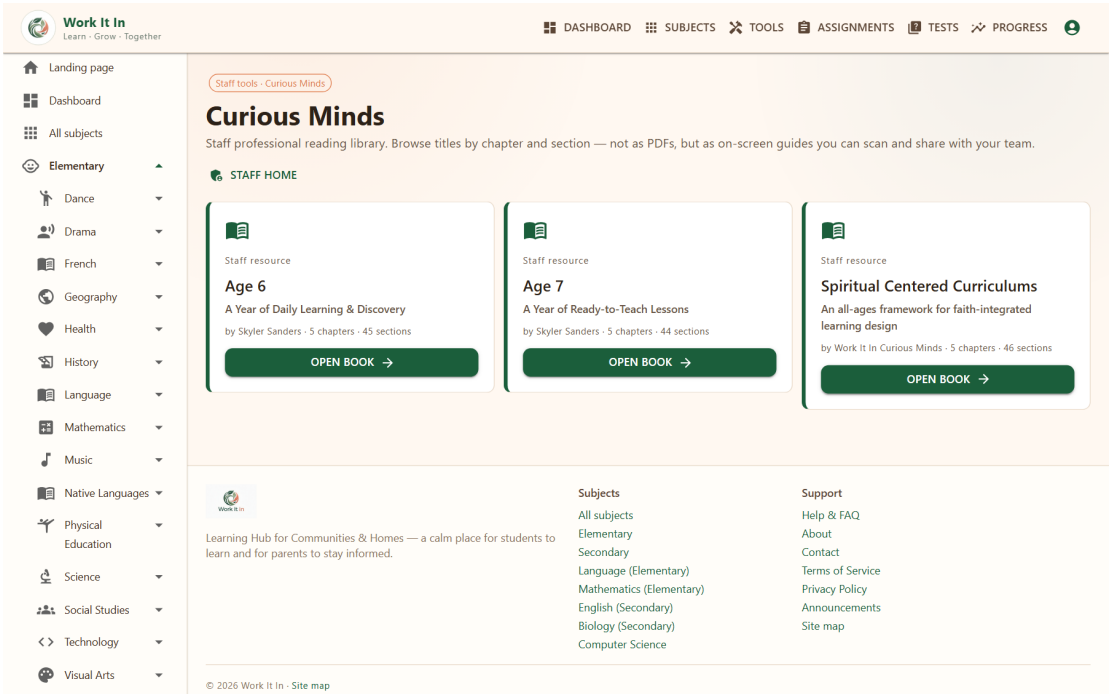

5. Curious Minds (staff reading)

Educators browse curated professional reading inside the same hub where teaching happens — including age-focused blueprints (Age 6, Age 7) so practice and PD stay close together.

6. Learner experience

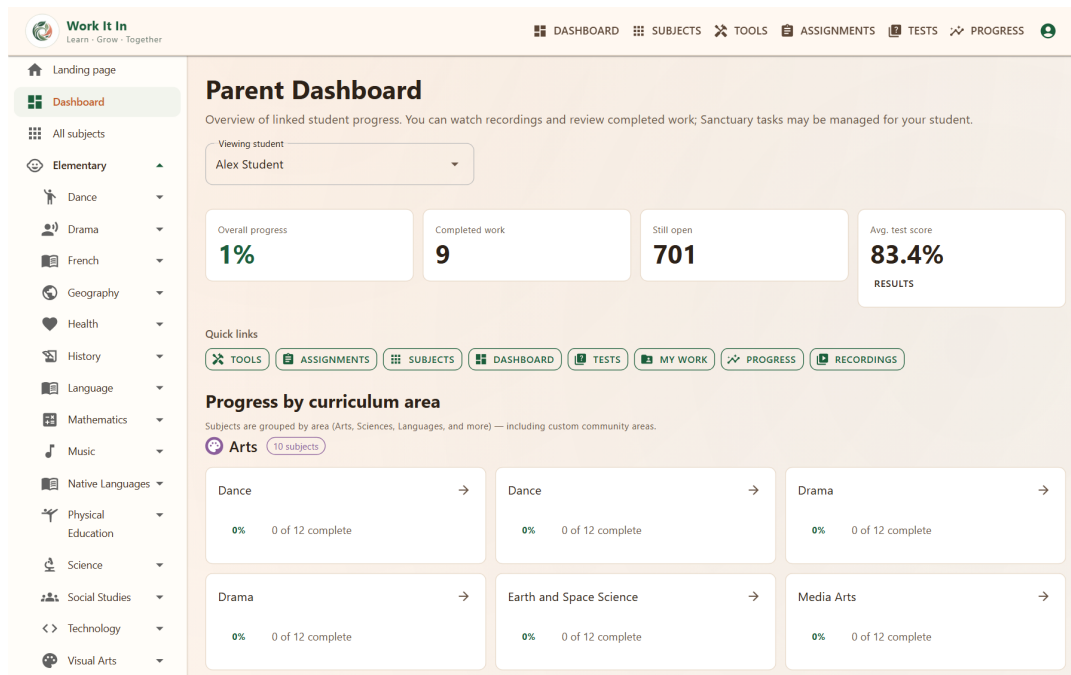
Learners submit home-learning packets and track status. Staff review the same files from submissions — one continuous loop from task to feedback.
